A Colorado Sex Offender Registry List includes only those persons who have been required by law to register, who are in compliance with the sex offender registration laws and those who were convicted as an adult of a sex offense or sex offenses. This list does not include persons who are on the sex offender registry solely for having been adjudicated or received dispositions as juveniles. Persons should not rely solely on the sex offender registry as a safeguard against perpetrators of sexual assault in their communities. The crime for which a person was convicted may not accurately reflect the level of risk.

The information provided by the Colorado Bureau of Investigation (CBI) is accurate as of the date and time the information is provided to the customer. The data maintained within the CBI Sex Offender Registration Database changes daily as records are updated. The CBI is not responsible for making notification of updates to the data once the extract is provided to the customer.

Neither the CBI, nor the State of Colorado, shall be responsible for any errors or omissions produced by the secondary dissemination of information from the CBI Sex Offender Registry database. Caution should be exercised when using any information obtained from a secondary source, making sure the records accessed are current and pertain to the person in question. Any concerns or errors discovered through secondary dissemination should be addressed to the provider of the information.

The General Assembly declares that by providing sex offender information to the public, it is to be used as an awareness tool to adequately protect citizens from these individuals. The use of the sex offender registry information to harass, intimidate, threaten, or in any way seek retribution on an offender through illegal channels is prohibited. Any person who engages or participates in such acts may be charged criminally.
